GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS:

- **Overview:** The IBHPC Jumper Show series is designed to provide riders the opportunity to practice their show jumping skills with the opportunity to 'try the next level'. Each class is \$10. Riders may enter in any combination of classes. Ribbons will be awarded through 6th place for each division for riders entered in both classes of the division. Divisions are listed on the entry form. All riders are welcome.
- Each Division is a different height and consists of 2 Classes:
 - **Timed Class** – Ride designated route in *expected* time with accuracy. If clear, jump another 5 jumps. Score based time and faults; closest to expected time and fewest faults, ranks highest. Expected time will be posted with the course map. An audible signal will be sounded if the rider did not jump the first portion of the course clear. Approximately 9 to 14 jumps.
 - **Power and Speed Class** – 'Power' section of the course is not timed and counts faults only. If a competitor has gone clean in the 'Power' section, they continue in the ring to the 'Speed' portion which counts time and faults. An audible signal will be sounded if the rider did not jump the 'Power' course clear. Score based on combination of faults and fastest time. Approximately 6 to 9 jumps.
- **Dress:** Rider attire is not judged. Dress casual, or dress up for the show clothes experience.
- **Planned Times** for each division are approximate. All entries within the division will be accommodated.
- **Entries:** \$10 per class. **Make checks payable to:** Iron Bridge Hounds Pony Club (IBHPC).
- **Provide Negative Coggins** within 12 months of competition date; as required by the State of Maryland.
- **Please email** us with your intention to attend so we can anticipate participation and keep you up to date. Signed Entry form, COGGINS, and entry fee are submitted at the Jumper Show. Additional classes may be added at the show.
- **Weather:** If the show is cancelled due to weather, an announcement will be place on the website, IronBridgeHoundsPonyClub.org and on the IBHPC Facebook page. If there is no announcement, the show will go on as scheduled.
- **DOGS** must be leashed at all times, HOWEVER - we prefer that they stay home.
- **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN WATER:** Farm is on well. Available for emergency only.

DIRECTIONS: 1201 Olney Sandy Spring Rd, Sandy Spring, MD 20860

From Washington Beltway: Take New Hampshire Ave. (Rte. 650) North from Beltway to Route 108 in Ashton (about 10 miles). Turn Left (West) on Route 108, and go 2 miles through Sandy Spring to Avalon Farm on the right.

From Baltimore Beltway: Take Route 70 North towards Frederick. GO South on Rte. 29 towards Columbia. Turn right (West) on Rte. 108 towards Clarksville. Stay on Rte. 108 through Ashton (intersection with New Hampshire Ave., Rte. 650). Continue 2 miles through Sandy Spring to Avalon Farm on your right.

From points North and West: Take Interstate 70 towards Baltimore to Rte. 97 (Georgia Avenue Extended) South, towards Olney. Stay on Rte. 97 until you reach Olney, (about 12 miles). Turn Left (East) on Rte. 108, and go 3 miles to Avalon Farm on your Left.

Looking on the Map? Avalon Farm is on Rte. 108, halfway between Olney and Ashton, in Montgomery County, Maryland. It is *approximately central to Frederick on the Northwest, Baltimore on the Northeast, and Washington, D.C. on the South.*

LARGE GOOSENECKS approaching from the East (Ashton) should continue beyond Avalon Farm to Sherwood Elementary School (immediately after the Farm on the right), and turn around in the school parking lot to approach from the West. It is a much easier approach to the driveway and avoids a large tree.
